

CCPA 2021 Annual Election Phone Voting Instructions

The election is being managed by a third-party, online service called ezVoteOnline.com. These are instructions for voting by phone. This is not a paper ballot. **Voting by phone costs the CCPA more money. Please only use this method if you absolutely cannot vote online.**

YOU MUST REQUEST YOUR BALLOT BEFORE 2pm FRIDAY 11/18/22 AND COMPLETE YOUR VOTING BEFORE 5pm.

In order to cast a vote by phone:

1. Call the Steven Berkson at the CCPA Voting Hotline: 541-321-0043 to get your **voter ID number**. If there is no answer, please leave a message indicating you wish to vote by phone. You will be called back.
2. With your ID number, call the **ezVoteOnline Voting Hotline at 301-660-8885**
3. On the recorded line, provide:
 - a. **Your name**
 - b. **The voter ID number you got from Steven**
 - c. **Then list each ballot question and how you vote on the issue.**
 - i. List up to 5 Board Candidates from the list of 6 running.
 - ii. Do you approve of the updated bylaws proposal?
